Laid out for John Stirruck 1100 Acres of land begining at a corner tree of John Henderson by Grunn Creek being a Red oke and running N.E.b.E into ye woods 640 Perches to a marked oke and from thence running E.b.N. 30 Perches to a marked poplar standing in Stone Creek from thence a long the Creek upon severall courses to a marked Gunne from thence N.W.b.N 168 Perches to a marked Red oke from thence S.W.b.W 590 Perches to a red oke standing by Grunn Creek from thence a long the Creek side upon severall courses to ye furst corner tree.
