



Pursuant to a warrant to me directed by Edward Pennington Surveyor General of the Province of Pennsylvania &c bearing date the 13th
day of the 11th month 1700/1 to resurvey unto Abel Jannoy a tract of land in the Township of Makefield and County of Bucks and
Province aforesaid which said tract begins at a popler standing by the side of the River Delaware being at a corner of Richard
Houghs land Thenoe west thirty deg^{rs} south fifty seven perches to an oak Then west Twenty deg^{rs} south thirty perches to an
oak Then west two deg^{rs} south thirty seven perches to a white oak Then west Thirteen deg^{rs} south forty eight perches to a
fifty six perches
to a black oak Then west six deg^{rs} south to a great forked black oak Then west one deg^r south one hundred and thirty perches to a gum
tree by a run sides Then west five deg^{rs} north Twenty eight perches to a white oak Then west two deg^{rs} north eighty nine perches
to a Spanish oak Then west three deg^{rs} south two hundred and Twenty perches to an oak Then still by the said Houghs land west
three hundred and seventy two perches to a white oak being another corner of the said Houghs land Then by Thomas Jannneys land
north four deg^{rs} west fifty seven perches to a white oak being another corner of other land belonging to the said Abel Jannoy
Then by the said land east four hundred and fifty perches to a gum tree in a swamp then by the (obl.) land and other land
formerly belonging to one Turnerlift east one deg^r south one hundred and fifty perches and fifty perches
to a white oak Then east eight deg^{rs} north fifty perches to a black Then east two deg^{rs} north eighty four
perches to a Spanish oak Then east eight deg^{rs} north ninety four perches to a Chestnut Tree Then east two deg^{rs} south eighty two perches to
a Spanish oak Then east Ten deg^{rs} north seventy eight perches to a Spanish oak standing by the River Delaware aforesaid Then down
the courses of the said River south sixty five deg^{rs} east ten perches Then south severity three deg^{rs} east sixteen perches Then south
seventy deg^{rs} east forty nine perches to the popler the place of beginning Resurveyed for three hundred sixty five acres & twelve
perches ~~the~~ the 13 day of the 2 month 1701 Phineas Pennington.
