Whereas, by virtue of a warrt from ye Propre bearing date ye 14th 12^{mo} 1683, there was granted to be survey'd unto Joⁿ Goodsonn a tract of land within ye Liberties of Philadelphia on Delaware side answerable to ye purchases of severall persons therein mentioned the whole proportion amounting to severall six acres in ye said Liberty, And whereas ye said Joⁿ Goodsonn could not purchase of every of ye severall persons aforesd their Respective Lotts in ye said Liberties to answer his obligation to ye Proprietor. But hath to that end purchased the Liberty lands proportionable belonging to ye purchasers following, severall whereof falling by Lott on ye Skoalkill side, and therefore likewise their liberty land there also. But in consideration of ye Proprietor's warrt afore mentioned wh^{ch} ordered severall purchasers therein, falling on Skoalkill side to be notwithstanding laid out unto ye said Joⁿ Goodsonn on Delaware side, Wee doe hereby ord^r the following purchasers their Liberty land to be laid out unto ye said Joⁿ Goodsonn on Delaware side notwithstanding any order or instruction than hast to ye contrary (viz.) unto Joⁿ Goodsonn in rt of Joⁿ Sybly whose wife is Relict of Joⁿ Martin, Purchaser of 500 acres, 8 acres in right of W^m Busby whose wife is Relict to Thomas Cary purchaser of 500 acres, 8 acres in right of Robt Adarties purchaser of 500 acres, 8 acres, in rt of Edw^d Martindale purchaser of a 1000 acres, 16 acres, in rt of Nicholas Walne purchaser of 1000 acres, 16 acres, in right of Richard Worrell purchaser of 500 acres, 8 acres, in rt of Rd Bunts purchaser of ²⁵⁰ ~~500~~ acres, 4 acres, and in rt of his owne purchase of 500 acres 8 acres all wh^{ch} aforesaid numbers amounting to 76 acres wh^{ch} said numbers with 4 acres more was according to ye Propri^r warrt and ord^r formerly laid out in one tract.

These are therefore in the Proprietors name to will and require thre^e ~~of~~ forthwith to make or cause to be made a returne of ye aforesaid tract into ye Secretarys office in order to have the same confirmed by Patten^t unto ye said Joⁿ Goodsonn Dated at Philadelphia ye 6th of ye 6th 1770 1694.
