



Pursuant to a war^t from the proprietors Corriss^{ee} of Prop^rty directed unto me bearing date the 22^d 10th 1701 I do hear by certifie that I have reassurvyd for Thomas Joanes & Company a certaine tract of land in Miciorn township one ye^e west sid^e of Scoolkeele begining at a popare marked being corner deviding it from John Robarts ye^e Masters land from thone by a line of marked trees and same land and other land of Robart Joanes east 12 degrees & 30 minit north 720 perches to a certaine rock making a fales in the River Scoolkeele from thone by the sevall thereof S. 53 E 36 perches thone S. 50 E 88 perches thon S. 28 E 36 perches to a Hickry marked being a corner deviding it from Onow Robarts land from thone by a line of trees and same land west south west 124 perches thone west 12 degrees south 56 perches to a poplare marked thone west 9 degrees north 28 perches thone west 4 degrees south 80 perches thon by the same land and ye^e land of Robart Robarts west 15 degrees & 30 minit south 518 perches to a stak set in ye^e ground being a corner deviding it from the said Robart Robarts land from thone north 18 degrees west by a line of marked trees deviding it from Robart Onowis land 160 perches to ye place of Begining containeing 679 acres of land and is according to the bounds above described.
