At the Requested of Isaac Norris of Fair Hill Esq: that wee granted him a resurvey on a Tract of land lying on Shickaseling Creek in the County of Lancaster which was formerly survey'd to Thomas Griffitts of this City Gentleman in Trust for the said Isaac Norris in pursuance of two warrants granted by the Commissioners of Property the one dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1718 for one thousand acres, & the other the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1719 for Five hundred acres; which Tract as it was survey'd in June 1720 falls short of 1500 acres with the usual allowance of six acres on each hundred for roads and Highways; These are to authorize & require thee to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed unto the said Isaac Norris the aforesaid Tract of land & make such addition of adjoining Land thereto as shall make up one thousand Five hundred acres with the above mentioned allowance for roads & Highways, & make return thereof into the Secretary's Office in order for a further confirmation. Given under my Hand & the lesser seal of our Province at Philadelphia this nineteenth day of October Anno Domini 1733.
