

By virtue of a warrant from ye Proprietary and Govern^t: Bearing date ye 23 of ye 9th 1770. 1683 directed to me I hereby certifie in to his Secretaryas office yt I have caused to be surveyed and set out ye 30th of ye ~~March~~ ^{March} set me unto George Wood Purchaser a certain piece or scall of land scituate lying and being in ye County of Chester in ye Township of NewTown, Begining at a corn^e marked post being ye corne tree of ye land of Richard Bonsall from thence N.E.b.E. by ye said land 901 perches to a corn^e marked tree from thence S.S. E by a line of marked trees ~~122~~ perches to a corn^e marked tree fro(obl) thence S.W. b. W. by a line of marked trees 401 perches to a corn^e marked tree from thence N.N. W. by a line(obl) of marked trees ~~122~~ and ^{five} perches to ye first mentioned Cor(obl) post, being two hundred sixty five acres of land also thirty acres more lying on ye Villady or Town ~~steed~~, Bounded to ye N.N. W. wth ye land of Richard Bonsall to ye N.E. b.E. wth ye land of Tho. Hood to ye S.S. E. wth ye land of John Haught to ye S.W. b.W. wth ye Street or Road of ye said township. Containing in all three hundred acres.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this
