



In pursuance of a Contract of the first of Nov'r, 1827, with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Penn'a & the authority therein stated, there was survey'd & calculated by virtue of Appn. No. 2584, granted by the Proprietary Government to Joseph Alston Jun'r, the 3d. Ap'l 1769. The above Tract of Land situate in Wilkins Township, Allegheny County, Containing three hundred acres, fifteen perches 6/10 of a perch & allowance of 6 P. CT

N.B. That part of the above survey marked A, includes the village of McCanic'sburg, proprietors James McBride & Othey Speer in right of George Croghan on location No. 21.

B. Interferes with survey belonging to the Heirs of General Butler in right of George McCulley. Patented.

C. Interferes with the survey of Daniel Mathews on a Warrant of 16th September 1772 in name of William Henry executed 17th November 1784. Patented.

D. Interferes with the claim of Harrather & Reed.

E. Interferes with the survey of Samuel Duffield executed 17th November 1784 on Wt. of 16th September 1772.
