



Articles of Agreement indentured made & agreed upon this 12th day of the 3^d M^o 1732 Between Thomas Winn of Blackley &c. yeoman^{both}
 and W^m Couch of the same place Cordwainer Whereas Thomas Winn & John ap John^{of the Kingdom of Great Britain did}
 formerly purchase of W^m Penn proprietary & Governor of the province aforesaid certain Quantities of land in the said pro-^{eight of ye said Province}
 vince In right of wth purchase there still remains 24 acres of Liberty Land untaken up. wth doth of right appertain to
 the aforesd Thomas Winn p^{ty} to these presents Now it is hereby covenanted & agreed by & between ye se^d parties And the
 for & in considerate of ye sum of 30⁰ to be paid to the se^d Thomas by se^d Couch as herein after de-
 cld Thomas Winn for himself his heirs Exec Adm^r doth hereby grant, bargain & sell to the se^d W^m Couch his heirs & assigns
 all his right to the se^d 24^a of Liberty Land & all warrants evidences & writings touching or concerning the same to hold to the
 se^d W^m Couch his heirs & assigns forever^x And the se^d W^m Couch for himself his heirs ex. & ad. doth covenant promise grant &
 agree to & wth the se^d Thomas Winn his heirs & assigns by these presents that he the se^d W^m Couch his heirs or assigns shall &
 will truly pay or cause to be paid to the se^d Thomas Winn his heirs ^{exc or adm^r of 30 ft. in manner aforesd that is to say the sum} the se^d sum of 20. 00⁰ the day next ensuing ye date hereof
 ye date hereof And the sum of 6. 13⁴ more thereof & provided always and it is hereby declared to be ye true intent & meaning of
~~the said articles~~ And that the se^d Thomas his heirs &c. shall & will be at ye request Cost & Charges of the se^d Couch &c. ²⁹⁸ ⁸⁶

 And it is hereby further covenanted & agreed by & between the se^d parties And the se^d Thomas Winn for himself his heirs &c. do obly
 covenant to wth se^d Couch (obly) that if the se^d land be not laid out to the satisfaction & content of se^d Couch that then & in such case all the
 above covenants shall from thence forth become null void & utterly extinct to all intents & purposes And the se^d Thomas Winn shall & will
 pay or cause to be paid to the se^d W^m Couch the sum of 10 pounds.
