



The above described piece of Meadow, contains sixty eight acres and nineteen perches out of which, if ten acres be taken for William Attwoods part, there will remain 58 acres and 19 perches which if divided into five parts, will give 11 Acres 99 perches & 8 tenths of a perch for each share, and as Richard Hockley as two shares, and the Heirs of George Fitzwater two shares, each of their parts will be 23 Acres & 40 1/2 and Thomas Lawrence's part 11 Acres, 99 perches & 8 tenths which makes added together 68 acres & 19 perches.
