

A. Draught of a Tract of land Situate in the Counties of Berks & Cumberland on the South side of the West Branch of Susquehanna River Surveyed the 30 th and 31 th days of March, and the ist 3 and 4th days of April 1769. To the Officers of the first and Second Batallion of the Pennsylvania Regiment. In Pursuance of an order No I dated the 3d day of February 1769. Containing Eight, Three hundred and eighty acres, and allowed of Six acres PCent for Roads &c. And Divided amongst them, as Directed by Leiut: Wiggans, who was appointed by them to see it done.
