A Draught of a Lot of Ground on the Peninsula, commonly called Presqu' Isle. Beginning at a Cedar post standing on the margin of Presqu' Isle Bay thence with the said Bay, South Eighty-five degrees & three quarters East Forty-one perches & two tenths of a perch to a Cedar post South seventy-four Degrees & an half East seventy-two perches to a Cedar post North thirty degrees & an half West sixty-eight perches to a Cedar post, and North eleven degrees & an half West fifty-six perches to a Cedar post thence leaving the Bay, South thirty-five degrees, twenty minutes West One hundred & eleven perches & eight tenths of a perch to the place of Beginning containing thirty Acres of Land near the entrance of the Harbour, Surveyed for the use of the United States, agreeably to an Act of the Legislature of the State of Pennsylvania bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1795.
