



By virtue of a warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> July 1758 surveyed  
the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1821 to Peter Hartman the above de-  
scribed tract of Land situated on the Lehigh Hills in  
Salisbury Township in the County of Lehigh (formerly  
Northampton) containing sixty nine acres and seventy  
perches and allowance of six per cent. &c.

That part containing six acres and seventy two perches  
was held in quiet possession for upwards of twenty one  
years as sworn to by Adam Smith and John Bauer  
(that is to say the present owner and his predecessors) said  
tract was surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup>. day of March A.D. 1840 -  
and the whole is now returned for John Apple.
