



A Draught of one hundred eighty five acres forty two perches of land, and the usual alluv. of six P cent for roads &c.
Situate in Wayne Township (formerly Cumberland) now Mifflin County part of a tract of land surveyed in August for John Armstrong Esqr. In pursuance of his warrant dated the 1st day of June 1762 granted unto him for 200^{rs}. Returned into the Secretaries Office 26 Sept 1766 ex signed John Lukens S.G.
