



Distribute on the head waters of Dunmore Run which empties into Eastman's River & on both sides of the Turkeyfoot Road in Brothers Valley Township Bedford County (now Greenville Township Somerset County) Surveyed the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January AD 1785 by Alex McLean Esq D.S. as appears by his official Draught thereof, but erroneously returned with regard to the S 56 E line being called 160 ps to sugar, when in fact it is 200 ps making the quantity of land as above stated instead of 292 as given in the original Draught examined & returned for Jacob Cledfely the present owner
