



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in the dry Valley in Buffalo Township in the County of Northumberland, Survey'd on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March 1792 by Hugh Beatty in Pursuance of his Warrant bearing dated the 31<sup>st</sup> August 1785. Together with a special Order of the Board of Property directing the Survey of the piece mark'd A (which was sold by Thomas Sutherland to Hugh Beatty) to be added to the said Beatty's Survey of sixty seven acres & three quarters, which makes in the whole One Hundred and seventeen Acres & three quarters, with the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c —
