



The above is a Draught of an Island in the River Susquehanna, in Heartick township, Lancaster County, called Rocky Island, about forty perches above Morrisons Rock, and about sixty perches below the lower Brushy Island, and about ten perches below the Bunch of Rocks, and opposite the Lands late of Thomas Cully Deceased on the Lancaster County shore, and opposite the Land of Christ: Burkholder (this applicant) on the York County shore containing one acre strict measure, surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the thirtieth day of June 1806 granted to Christian Burkholder
