Deceased (agreeably to the courses and distances made by Charles Lukens Esq. on the 9th of April 1775 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Wm. Bell dated the 27th of February 1775) and now Resurveyed in pursuance of an order of Resurvey dated the 14th of January 1807 granted to Jonathan Walker Situate in oval limestone valley Adams Township Lycoming County bounded as above containing three hundred and eighters acres and allowance of Six percent for Roads &c.
