



A draught of abstract of Land situated on Monogahela River in Washington County (Barred Fairview) Executed in pursuance of an Order for three hundred and acres granted Nathan Hamm on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1769 and 1793 1/2. Containing three hundred four acres and a quarter and allowance of 6 per cent Surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November 1792.
