


Arch. M. Carr and Jane Moore



In pursuance of a warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> of Feb<sup>y</sup>, 1808, there was surveyed to Archibald M. Carr and Jane Kiscaden and James Matthews Administrators of Arch<sup>d</sup>. Kiscaden, dec<sup>d</sup>, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1808, the above described Tract of land, Containing four hundred and nineteen acres and one hundred and thirty perches and allowances of 60 p Cent & 1/4, Situate in Buffalo Township Armstrong County on the waters of Nicholsons run. Being the same tract which Stephen Gaper, formerly Dep<sup>y</sup> Sur<sup>r</sup> Dur<sup>r</sup> for John Scott & David Todd on their Improvement &c. By warrant of 1<sup>st</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup> 1808
