The Commissioners appointed for Settling the Claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Monongahela Yohogania, and Ohio, do hereby Certify that Otho Brashers Assignee of William Collier is intitled to four hundred Acres of land in the Counties of Monongahela & Yohogania, on the waters of Dumblaps Creek to include his Settlement made in the Year of our Lord, one Thousand Seven Hundred, and Seventy Five under our hands, at Redstone, old fort the Sixteenth Day of December 1779, in the fourth year, of the Commonwealth.
