



The Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Monongahela & Ohio do hereby certify that Charles Bonner is Entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Buffalo to include his Actual Settlement made in the Year one thousand Seven hundred Hundred and Seventy seven & also a right in pretension to one thousand acres Adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Coles fort the twenty second day of Feb 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
