In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783, for the sale of certain Lands, therein mentioned; and by virtue of a Commission to me directed under the Hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor General of the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 2^d day of August 1783 the above tract of Land containing two hundred & six Acres and twenty perches and Allowance of 6 Pr Cent for Roads &c was surveyed on the 18th day of June 1785.
