



A draught of a tract of land situate in Greenville (formerly Derry) Township Mifflin County Contg. one hundred & Twenty acres and Forty nine perches and all of six per cent for roads &c. Being parts of two tracts one Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 on Warrant to Henry Buck dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1795. The other, a part of a tract Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1823 in pursuance of a warrant to Abraham Snyder, dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1823. The above Surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1841.

Examined this 17<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1851 and found to be correct.
