



A Draught of 168^a 83/2 perches of land in Oliver (formerly Wayne) Township Mifflin County Penna being one entire tract which appears to have been Surveyed April 24th 1806 in pursuance of a Warrant to Matthias Brackney for 30^a dated Nov 17th 1772, and said to contain 30^a 46 ps & allowance &c. Also part of a tract which appears to have been surveyed by James Harris Nov 14th 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Elliott for 150^a dated August 29th 1793 Resurveyed by Wm Harris April 23rd & 24th 1806 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of property dated August 5th 1805, and a warrant dated August 29th 1793 and said to contain 163^a 110 ps & allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Examined Dec 13th 1851, and the above found to contain 168^a 83/2 ps as above shown.
