

Surveyed April 26th 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant ted Clerander Burnes bearing date the 6th day of De cember 1830 containing (exclusive of the interference with David Ruples survey designated by dotted lines) 119 Acres and the usual allowance and inclusive of said interference 146 Aeres and 80 perches situate on brabapple a branch of Wheeling creek in Richhill township inthe Vacob Spangler Esgr reveyor General of Tennsylvania Mr Burns has two secent improvements but no actual resident sette ment on the above survey. And I believe the whole is included in what is called Ryerson's Surray within the dotted lines is hark of the survey of David 25 day of April 1831 Both parties say that they fontend for the Board of Property
