



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1793 granted to William Bingham, and Order of Resurvey dated May 23<sup>d</sup> 1845 granted on Petition of Ralph Hawkins Surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1845 the above described Tract of Land Situate in Lackawaxen Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining land Surveyed to Mordica Roberts on the Lackawaxen River containing four hundred and Thirty acres Eighty Nine perches and allowance of six 1/2 Ct for roads &c. per John T. Cross Dd to John Saporte Esq. Surveyor General of Penna.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty third day of February 1904.
