



Situate on the Big Lick branch of Dunning's creek in St Clair Township Bedford County containing 158 acres 50 perches Allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c Surveyed by Hiram Blackburn the 21<sup>st</sup> of January 1853, Being part of a tract that originally contained 293 1/4 acres Allowance Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of William Bradford dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> of June 1763.
