Archibald McCall of the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> Merchant enters a Cadastre to the Granting or patent to James & Wm Blaine or either of them for the above Survey the 5<sup>d</sup> McCall claiming 200 acres of 5<sup>d</sup> Land by virtue of a Contract between him & John Black whose Assignees they or one of them is & by virtue of an Improvement & Survey in the name of Joseph Irwin & of a warrant of Acceptance therefor issued on the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1795.
