The improvements on the above tract are a good house
& Barn, a plantation cleared, an orchard, and is an old settlement, but when
commenced cannot be ascertained - the lines of the survey on the ground are
first regular line around the whole tract, showing by the clock the age of
54 years. There also some line marks of a younger date, in some of the lines.
