



Survey in Allegheny Township Huntingdon County first
Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Baughton
& Samuel Wharton dated the 25th day of July 1766 which
was said to contain 454 1/4 acres & the usual allowance.
Now Resurveyed the 3rd day of Oct 1822 (in pursuance
of an Order of the Board of Property to me directed Bear-
ing date the 5th day of Sept 1822) and is found to
contain 454 3/4 acres and allowance of six per cent for
Roads &c.
