



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated
the Twenty-Seventh day of February 1733 Surveyed to
Bodwick Claypo a tract of Land Situate in Oley in the
County of Philadelphia Beginning at a post in the line
of William Roberts Land thence by the same North
Seventy Degrees West twenty one perches and by
land of Peter Helton the same Course one hundred
and fifty two perches to a post thence by the S^d
Helton's Land North twenty three Degrees East eleven
perches and by Land of Owen Richards the same
Course one hundred & four perches & by Vacant Land
Eighty One perches to a Stone thence by Vacant Land
South Seventy Degrees East one hundred & Sevene Three
perches to a post thence by land of Benjamin Boone
South twenty Degrees West one hundred & Ninety Six
perches to the place of Beginning Containing Two hun-
dred acres with the usual allowance of six per cent -
Surveyed April 20th 1734 By Nich^o Scull.
