



The above is a draught of a survey made October 10th, 1792, in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Conn dated August 28th, 1792, on the waters of Laurel Run a branch of the South fork of Ten Mile Creek in the County of Washington containing 367 Acres with an allowance of 6 per Cent. to be called Rick Hills.
