



Situated in Darree Township Huntingdon County, containing one hundred sixty six acres 104 perches & allow. It being part of a tract of Land first surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Alexander Campbell, dated 21st of March 1811. The original Survey was said to contain 268 acres 121 perches & allowance. This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 29th & 30th days of July 1831.
