

The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 3<sup>d</sup> day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Robert Calhoon for 400 Acres of Land Dated February the tenth 1794. Adjoining James Johnson on the South to the West of the Venango Path including a Stream that empties into the Ohio North and West of the River Ohio Allegheny and Conawango Creek on the Waters of Lowries Run Called Bear Hollow. Containing four hundred thirty Eight and an half Acres and thirteen poles together with the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Cent for Roads.
