


Donation Land



The above is a draft of a Survey made March 12th 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted Sam'l Clarke on the 4th day of Jany. 1794. Situate North west of the Ohio River on the Waters of Beaver Creek Adjoining Land granted to David Bradford Called Red Bank- Containing 400 Acres together with the usual Allowance of 6pr Cent
