



Situated on the Waters of Lynns Run in Washington Township Fayette County and Surveyed in part 9th. February 1785 but being disputed it was postponed for want of Evidences until 19th. May 1786 then finished and again altered In Consequence of an Order of the Honorable Board of Property dated at Philadelphia 4th. February 1788 and Returned in Consequence of a Certificate granted by the Virginia Commissioners, as followeth— We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to Unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby certify that Jonathan Johnson Assignee of Edward Cook is intitled to four hundred acres ^{of} Land in the County of Yohogania, Situate on the Waters of Monongalia to include his Settlement made in the year 1769 also a right in preemption to one thousand acres adjoining thereto — Given under our hands at Coxes fort the 11 February 1780 & in the fourth year of the Commonwealth. ret'd. 19 Mar. 88 Francis Peyton
