We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the County^s of Monungahela Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that John Craft is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in Monungahela County Lying on the Waters of ten Mile- to include his Settlement made in the year- One thousand seven hundred and seventy four- Given under our hands at Cocks fort the nineteenth day of January 1780- in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
