



The Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Half-Moon Township formerly Cumberland, now Centre County, Containing three hundred and fifty two Acres, Sixty perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. being part of a large tract of land Containing four hundred and twenty four Acres and one quarter granted to Joseph Coleman by an order N<sup>o</sup>. 418 dated the first day of August 1766, and Surveyed to him the first day of October following - and Subdivided as above represented the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818.
