



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the first day of December 1736. Surveyed to George Denet a tract of Land situate in the County of Philad^a being part of the Mⁿor of Springfield Beginning at a post in a line of Nicholas Scull's Land thence by land of Edward Farmar South East 128 perches to a Hickory thence by part of the Mⁿor South West 157 perches to a post thence by a road North 50° West 128 perches to a Hickory by the said Road thence by part of the said Mⁿor and Land of said Nicholas Scull North East 168 perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred & Thirty Acres.

Surveyed the 24th. of Jan^y 1736/7
