



Situate in Hellam Township in the County of York, containing
as above set forth 679 13 perches and allowance &c. being part of a
larger tract of 2259 & 6 1/2 ps &c. which was originally surveyed by George
Stevenson late D.S. on the 12th day of July A.D. 1754. in pursuance of a
warrant Granted to Cornelius Cooper bearing date the 18th day of Octo-
ber 1753, and afterwards resurveyed and a piece of Vacancy add-
ed. The above resurveyed and divided off from the said larger
tract of Land on the 2d day of May A.D. 1810, at the request of the
