

The above is a Draft of a tract of land situate on the waters of Travis Creek on the south side of the Ohio River in Hanover Township.

Executed the 1st of June 1822 in pursuance of a warrant granted to dated 28th May 1822 Samuel Connelly for sixteen acres of land, containing fourteen acres & one hundred & thirty nine perches and the allowance of six percent for Roads &c.

I Hugh McCullough D.S. in and for the County of Beaver do hereby certify that there was an actual resident settlement on the ground at time of survey
