



The above Draft(s) respectively describe two Tracts of Land Situate in Anttrim Township in the County of Franklin (formerly in the County of Cumberland). Containing in the whole Twenty-one Acres and 11.8 Perches and an Allowance proportional to Six P Cent for Roads &c. Survey'd October 26th 1792 in pursuance of a Warrant granted by the late Proprietaries to Elias Davison for Twenty Acres of Land joining John Rule and his own Land on different Lines &c. bearing Date the 17th Day of June 1776.
