

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 4<sup>th</sup> of February 1795  
 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Dunlap for 400 Acres  
 of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 1794. Situate North and West  
 of the River Ohio on the Waters of Conaquenssing Creek Adjo-  
 ining Land Granted to Mark Biddle. Called Dunster Containing  
 four Hundred Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>r</sup>. Cent for Roads  
 Jonathan Leet, D.S.
