Originally surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. and now Resurveyed by the old lines on the 25<sup>th</sup> of 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1814 in pursuance of a Warrant for 50<sup>as</sup> Granted to John Doherty bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1796 and at the request of the owner Jonathan Pettigall the same is returned for Confirmation.
