ing as above set forth 15<sup>ac</sup>s of 20 ps of Allowance &c Surveyed  
the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June A.D. 1812 for John Furrey. In pursuance  
of a Warrant for 13<sup>ac</sup>s Granted him bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup>  
day of May A.D. 1812.

N.B. The improvements on the above described Tract of land at the time of surveying the same were a log dwelling house with a family living in the same &c. And about six or seven acres of winter grain growing thereon rendering it an actual personal resident Settlement with a manifest intention of making it a place of abode & means of supporting a family
