



The Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Dickenson Township, Cumberland County,  
Containing Two hundred and two Acres and Allowance of six per cent for Roads  
etc. Surveyed in dispute betwixt Daniel Funk and Thomas Thornburg the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
day of February 1797 in pursuance of an order of the Honorable Board  
of Property dated Dec<sup>r</sup>. 5<sup>th</sup> 1796. Note there is one hundred and  
fifty seven acres and one hundred and thirty one perches and All  
allowance of an interference (included in the above Survey) with  
Thornburgh's Survey made for him some time past in which  
there is about one acre and three quarters of Funk's Improv  
ement and about sixteen Apple trees as represented above.
