



A Draft of a tract of land situated in Shirley Township, Huntingdon
(formerly Bedford) County, Containing two hundred and forty-seven
acres, one hundred and eight perches and allowance of six feet land.

First surveyed on the 10th day of August, 1784, by George Woods,
Hand D. S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Bartholomew
Davis, dated the 17th day of February, 1740/5. Re-
surveyed, the errors of the original survey corrected, and other
land included, the 10th day of July, 1811, in pursuance of an
Order of the Board of Property, granted on the 28th day of
June 1811, to John Bell, Martin Bell, Rev. A. K. Bell
and Dr. Franklin Bell.
