

A draught of abstract of land called \_\_\_\_\_ situated in the County of Luzerne, Adjoining Paul Funk & others. Survey'd the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 1792 for Frederick Funk in possession of a warrant bearing date the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 1792 containing Four hundred one acres of eighty two perches of the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads etc.
