By virtue of a warrant dated the sixth day of April A.D. 1865, and same directed, I surveyed the twenty fourth day of May 1865, for James W. Daniels the above described improved tract of land containing three hundred and fifty nine acres and one hundred and thirty five perches (3.5913.135 pa 18.582) and allowances of six per cent. Situate in Frank Township Forest County Pa. which land has been improved since the first day of May 1848. The south-western portion of said described tract, (containing 22.0 acres, 68 perches and allowances) being claimed by Joseph T. Dobbie, was by me previously surveyed for him by virtue of a Warrant dated on the eleventh day of January 1865
