



Situate in Shrewsbury Township in the County of York, Originally Surveyed by William Karsner late d.s. on the 19<sup>th</sup> of the 10<sup>th</sup> mo. 1787, in pursuance of a warrant for 100<sup>£</sup> granted to John Gabel bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> day of August A.D. 1772, And now at the request of the Present owner John Kramer. We are desired to make a return of the draught as calculated & examined and find the same to contain 84<sup>2</sup> ft. 10 1/2 in. per acre. The seventh day of December anno Domini 1804.
